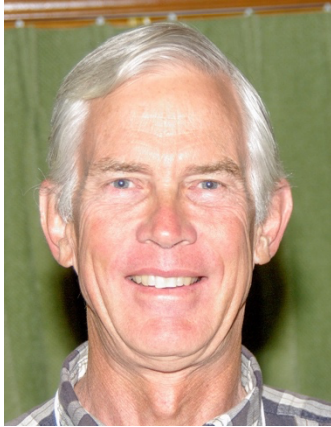


Andy Allen
