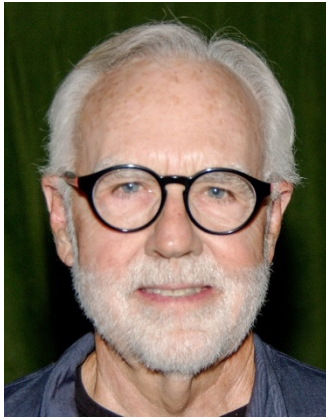


Danny Ferguson
